**Law 675 (Sect. 101) Public Interest Extern Clinic:** Students register for summer school even though the class is front-loaded. Open to 2L and 3L students. A cumulative GPA of 2.6 is required (for students who matriculated before June 9, 2008, a cumulative GPA of 2.45 is required). Class sessions will meet Monday, May 11 and Tuesday, May 12, 2009 from 9:00am to 4:00pm in Room 204. Classes do not meet during the summer session. (Prof: Rudasill/TBD)

**Law 672 (Sect. 101) Judicial Extern Clinic:** Students register for summer school even though the class is front-loaded. Open to 2L and 3L students who want to clerk for a federal or state judge during the summer. A cumulative GPA of 2.8 is required (for students who matriculated before June 9, 2008, a cumulative GPA of 2.65 is required). Class sessions will meet Monday, May 11 and Tuesday, May 12, 2009 from 9:00am to 4:00pm in Room 206. Classes will not meet during the summer session. (Alice Noble-Allgire)

The last day of regular classes is August 4, 2009. August 5 is reserved for a reading period. Final exams will be Thursday & Friday, August 6 & 7. Commencement is Saturday, August 8.
