Rule Relating to Outside Employment

ARTICLE V — STUDENT AFFAIRS

. . . .

3. Student Employment

A student may not be employed (for pay or as a volunteer) more than 20 hours per week in any week in which the student is enrolled in more than 12 class hours. The Associate Dean shall require a student who undertakes more than 20 hours of employment to reduce their course load to 12 class hours or less, qualify as a part-time student, or withdraw.
