‡ Non-resident students may apply for in-state residency by establishing “bona fide” residency in Illinois, and are granted in-state residency for the next semester after fulfilling all requirements and the 6 month residency period. ❖ Federal Funds (Stafford subsidized and unsubsidized loans) are **automatically** available to law students enrolled in six credit hours or more. In order to receive Stafford loans, a **FAFSA** must be filed (available at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)). The SIU Financial Aid Office will prepare award letters for law students approximately mid-March. When your award letter is ready to view, the SIU Financial Aid Office will send you an email.
