### Student Budget for the Summer Session 2011 based on 6 credit hours:

Any law student who is registered for at least a 3-hour law class for Summer Session is eligible to borrow loans for the costs listed above. This also applies to anyone doing an internship or externship away from the Carbondale area.

‡Tuition is \$385.80 per credit hour for IL resident and \$997.50 per credit hour for Non-IL resident. Tuition rates above are based on 6 credit hours.

If you take more than 6 credit hours; you can request additional loan money once summer semester begins to cover the cost of tuition and fees for the additional credit hours.

Those additional costs are as follows:

7 credit hours/resident:	+ tuition 385.80	+ fees 89.00	= 474.80
8 credit hours/resident:	+ tuition 771.60	+ fees 178.00	= 949.60
9 credit hours/resident:	+ tuition 1157.40	+ fees 267.00	=1424.40

7 credit hours/non-res:	+ tuition 997.50	+ fees 89.00	=1086.50
8 credit hours/non-res:	+ tuition 1995.50	+ fees 178.00	=2173.50
9 credit hours/non-res:	+ tuition 2992.50	+ fees 267.00	=3259.50

Students may borrow the needed amount by securing outside funding through an SIU Graduate PLUS Loan. If a student has any federal govt money left from the Fall 10/Spring 11 academic year; then that would be available first.
