Additionally, both **Third Place** and recognition for submitting the **Best Brief** was given to another South Texas College of Law team including Andrew Bender, Kathleen Jo Muncie, and Amber Burton. Their Team Number was 2016. The **Best Overall Oralist** was Ritika Rodrigues from the University of Alabama School of Law, while the **Best Preliminary Round Oralist** was Kathleen Jo Muncie of South Texas. Juvenile Court Judges Training
