

Bar Examination and Registration Checklist First Year

- ❑ I have examined the requirements of the jurisdiction where I would like to practice law.

- ❑ I have complied with the requirements and deadlines of this jurisdiction.

- ❑ I have determined the subjects that will be tested on the bar exam in this jurisdiction.

- ❑ I have completed the first year law student application (if required by this jurisdiction). I understand that if I do not complete an application during my first year of law school, that the fees will be considerably higher.

- ❑ I have looked into commercial bar review courses. I have considered applying for a bar review course during my first year when the cost is considerably lower.

- ❑ I have considered the bar requirements when choosing courses during my legal education. I will remember, however, that any course that helps me learn legal analysis and writing will be helpful, even if the subject matter is not covered on the bar exam.

- ❑ I have reviewed my performance on final exams with my law school professors. If I am having trouble writing exams, I am asking for help in writing a better exam.
