

Bar Examination and Registration Checklist Second Year

- ❑ I have re-checked the requirements of the jurisdiction where I want to practice law because they may have changed since my first year of law school.

- ❑ I have complied with the requirements and deadlines of this jurisdiction.

- ❑ I have determined the subjects that will be tested on the bar exam in this jurisdiction.

- ❑ I have considered the bar requirements when choosing courses. I will remember, however, that any course that helps me learn legal analysis and writing will be helpful, even if the subject matter is not covered on the bar exam.

- ❑ I have planned ahead financially so I will have enough money for a bar review course and for living expenses while studying for the bar exam. I have looked into applying for a bar examination loan to help cover expenses.

- ❑ I do not plan to work during the period that I need to be studying for the bar exam. This includes the time during the bar review course.

- ❑ I have attended the annual presentation by the bar examiners held at School of Law.

- ❑ I plan to take the MPRE in summer after my second year or during my third year of law school.
