Any law student who is registered for at least a 3-hour law class for Summer Session is eligible to borrow loans for the costs listed above. This also applies to anyone doing an internship or externship away from the Carbondale area.

‡Tuition is \$340.20 per credit hour for IL resident and \$950 per credit hour for Non-IL resident. Tuition rates above are based on 5 credit hours. If you take a 3 or 4 credit hour class you will pay less; if you take 6 or 7 credit hours you will pay more. If you take more than 5 credit hours; once summer school begins you can request additional loan money to cover the cost of tuition and fees for the additional credit hours.

Students may borrow the needed amount by securing outside funding through an SIU Graduate PLUS Loan or a private/alternative educational lender of your choice. If a student has any federal govt money left from the Fall 08/Spring 09 academic year; then that would be applied first.
