

# Information for Visiting Applicants

Southern Illinois University School of Law is a **full-time, day-time** program and applications will be entertained for Fall, Spring and Summer semesters. Acceptance of **visiting** applications is always discretionary. Southern Illinois University School of Law does not have a part-time program available.

Students interested in applying as a **visiting** student must:

- Be in good-standing at an ABA-accredited law school.
- Have completed at least one full year at an ABA-accredited law school (hours can usually vary between 29-31 credit hours). If student has completed more than one full year of study, credit will be given for courses in excess of one year only in exceptional cases.

All of the following documents must be received in order to provide a **complete transfer application**:

- Application
- \$50 Application fee
- Memorandum to the Admissions Committee answering all five questions
- Current Résumé (uploaded with online application).
- LSDAS Report (Report will be requested by us and sent from LSAC).
  - a. Current registration for LSDAS.
  - b. LSAT taken within past five years.

**Submit or Send supplemental materials below directly to school:**

- Supplemental documents and explanations for Character & Fitness section of application, if applicable
- Official law transcript sent directly to SIU from your current law school showing grades earned in all first year law courses
- Letter of Good Standing from the law school dean/registrar certifying that you are in good academic standing and have the school's permission to visit
